Rules and regulations

For the smooth operation of the Judo Club

Composition of the Board

The board is composed of a president, a secretary, a treasurer, and a representative from the *Federesen blong Judo blong Vanuatu* with a state degree (if available). The current composition is stated at the bottom of this document.

Subscription

1. The annual subscription is subject to revision each year.
2. The subscription must be paid each quarter, payable to "Judo Club of Port - Vila" (in 1 check, or 3 deposited checks cashed the 5th of each month).
3. Each started month is due.
4. A medical certificate of contraindication to the practice of Judo or Ju-Jitsu will be required for any claim.

Registration requirements

At the time of registration the following must be provided:

1. The check(s) for the quarterly subscription and payment of the licence.
2. The registration form, discharge, photographic release form, and the rules and regulations to read and sign up on the day of registration.

Club responsibility

1. Parents are responsible for their children up until the arrival of the teacher on the mat, then from the end of the session.
 2. The club can't be held responsible for any problems occurring between the parking and the Dojo.
 3. Children must arrive on time to their sessions and can't leave without the permission of the instructor.
 - 4. Parents aren't allowed in the Dojo. They'll be able to measure the progress of their children several times a year during dedicated sessions.**
 5. Appropriate clothing and respect for people and equipment are mandatory within the club. Anyone displaying misconduct or being incorrect during training or trips may be excluded temporarily or permanently.
 6. In case of accident, parents and the local casualty department will be contacted.
 7. Insurance has been taken out at Sportscover (Company number: 31627)
Section 4.21 Injury assistance = 100 000 vt (maximum per claim)
Section 431 medical expense = 10 000 vt (maximum per claim) (...)
- Judo is not a risk-free activity; the local insurance does not fully cover all kind of injuries. It is strongly advised to take out private individual insurance.

The club is a member of the Federesen blong Judo blong Vanuatu

Functioning of the *Federesen blong Judo blong Vanuatu*:

The *Federesen blong Judo blong Vanuatu* is an association affiliated to Vasanoc and international bodies.

The board of the *Federesen* is composed of a president, a treasurer, and a secretary general; it provides a national technical director (judo teacher).

Kimonos rental

Kimonos are rented 500 vatu per month; a deposit of 3000 vatu (uncollected) will be required.

Public holidays

Judo sessions will be cancelled during Vanuatu public holidays and the 14th of July (without rescheduling). In case of natural disasters (earthquakes, hurricane, tsunamis...), sessions may also be cancelled without refund or replacement.

Judo teacher authorized absences

The teacher may be absent during the year for the following reasons:

- Disease
- International and national competitions
- Training

If more than one course per pupil and per the month is not provided, classes will be rescheduled.

Safety, hygiene and use of facilities

1. Judokas must have clean hands and feet and trimmed fingernails. Judokas won't be allowed access to the tatami if the teacher believes these rules are not respected.
2. Judokas must have a clean kimono and a pair of flip-flops or slippers to go from the changing room to the tatami.
3. Judo rules imply that the colors from the vest and trousers of the kimono match: either all white or all blue.
4. Judo rules imply that for a competition boys won't wear anything under the kimono vest and girls will wear a white T-shirt under it.
5. Long hair must be tied with an elastic (hair slides are prohibited).
- 6. Are not allowed on the mat:**
 - a. All jewelry (watches, bracelets, earrings, piercing...).**
 - b. Candy, chewing gum and any other foodstuff.**
 - c. Anything of value (the club cannot be held responsible in case of loss or theft.)**
7. Judokas undertake to respect the places they attend, to leave the toilet of *Fit For Life* in a clean state and not to overuse paper.

Note: Each player must carry a bottle of water to class.
